		Score	Comments
1.	Bending Poles A minimum of four posts/poles/cones etc in a line. Walk or trot through.		
2.	Corridor Two poles (a minimum of 10ft long) on the floor a maximum of 3ft apart. Walk or trot through.		
3.	Halt The pony should stand still for 10 seconds without the handler holding it.		
4.	Tarpaulin Walk over a tarpaulin/sacks on the floor.		
5.	Sideways Pole Place a pole (min 10ft long) on the floor. The horse should step over the pole so the front feet are on one side and the back feet on the other and walk sideways along the pole without touching it.		
6.	Trotting Poles A minimum of two trotting poles in a row.		
7.	One Handed Walking Pick up and object with one hand and lead the pony around some of your obstacles one handed before returning your object to where you began.		
8.	Rein Back Walk into the corridor so that the pony's front feet at in line with the far end of the poles and rein back through the corridor.
