Scores: Completing an obstacle in walk – 3 points, trot - 5 points, or canter – 7 points. There is a bonus 3 points for style. The tarpaulin, sideways pole and rein back must only be executed in walk.

		Score	Comments
1.	<b>Bending Poles</b> A minimum of four posts/poles/cones etc in a line.		
2.	<b>Corridor</b> Two poles (a minimum of 10ft long) on the floor a maximum of 3ft apart.		
3.	<b>Bending Poles In-hand</b> Walk or trot only.		
4.	<b>Corridor In-hand</b> Walk or trot only.		
5.	<b>Mounting</b> Pony must stand still whilst the rider mounts either from the floor or a mounting block.		
6.	<b>Tarpaulin</b> Walk over a tarpaulin/sacks on the floor.		
7.	<b>Sideways Pole</b> Place a pole (min 10ft long) on the floor. The horse should step over the pole so the front feet are on one side and the back feet on the other and walk sideways along the pole without touching it.		
8.	<b>Jump</b> Jump a small jump.		
9.	<b>Rein Back</b> Walk into the corridor so that the pony's front feet at in line with the far end of the poles and rein back through the corridor.
