RULES & GUIDANCE

This is an event for Exmoor Ponies registered in Section 1 and Section X of the EPS Studbook. Showing attire is optional, but please ensure that riders and handlers are smart and safe. We encourage you to have fun and enter into the spirit of this show.

- 1. Entry to the show is at your own risk, we cannot be held responsible for your participation in this event. It is your responsibility to ensure the safety of your handlers, riders and ponies
- 2. All photographs and videos must have been taken on or after 14th November 2020
- 3. No professional photography or videography
- 4. All videos must be filmed in landscape. All dressage tests must be filmed from C.
- 5. Once the entries for this event have closed, substitutions or alterations to submitted footage will not be accepted
- 6. Ridden ponies must be 4 years old or over
- 7. Properly fastened BSI standard riding hats must always be worn when mounted and for handlers under the age of 14
- 8. Ponies under the age of 2 must not be bitted
- 9. There should be no writing included in any videos and no talking to the camera
- 10. The welfare of ponies is paramount and no lame, sick or overly fat or underweight ponies should be exhibited
- 11. Whips are not permitted in classes 4-9
- 12. Spurs are not permitted in any class
- 13. Foals may not be exhibited at this event
- 14. Conformation and breed type will not be judged
- 15. Video submissions will be used to create spectator videos. Photographs and videos may also be used for promotional purposes. Should you not wish for your submissions to be included please email exiefest@gmail.com

Classes 1-8 will be judged using the appropriate scoring sheets. These will be returned to the exhibitor by e-mail after the results have been announced.

A catalogue will be available to download on ShowingScene.com on Sunday 13th December. The first spectator video will be live on Monday 14th December on the ExieFest YouTube Channel and subsequent videos will be released each evening at 8pm. Results will become available once spectator videos and judging has concluded.
