Young Handler

In these classes it is the stock handler, not the animal, which is to be judged. Name and age of handler must be entered on the entry form. Prize money and special rosettes for all entries forward.

All competitors must have been involved in the preparation of their exhibits and must lead, handle and control their own animal in the ring. To be judged on presentation, handling ability of animal and general turnout of both the handler and the animal. Handlers are to be appropriately dressed for the breed they are exhibiting and the animal should be suitable for their age and size.

All major prize winners are expected to take part in the Grand Parade or its equivalent; children under 18 years must be accompanied and under the supervision of a competent and experienced adult at all times.
