General Information

- The Pygmy Goat classes will be run under the ruling of the Pygmy Goat Club.
- To enter the breed classes all exhibitors must be a member of the Pygmy Goat Club and all entrants registered; or in the case of kids under 12 months old eligible to be registered with the Pygmy Goat Club.
- No goat must be brought to the show in kid or has kidded within 30 days of the show.
- No goat can be entered if previously owned or bred by the judge.
- Classes with one entry may be amalgamated.
- All dates to be calculated at the date of the show
- All stock must be accompanied by a current AML movement licence.

Entry fee is £5 per animal per class
