# Student Blacksmith Competition    **Start At: 20/09/2025 09:00**

Your college students are invited to enter a live student blacksmithing competition to design and make a flower which will be judged on Sunday when all exhibits are completed.

Entries close Monday 15 September or sooner if entries reach capacity.

College students will have the chance to compete on a coke forge, material will be supplied.

Clothes:

Students must wear:

- Stout boots - preferably with steel toecaps. Leather hiking boots or Dr Martin style boots can be worn if steel toecap boots are not available.
- Long sleeve shirt to protect arms – preferably all cotton.
- Jeans or cargo trousers to protect legs – preferably all cotton.

The clothes may get burnt while forging. A Leather apron and gloves will be supplied. You will need to wear these while blacksmithing.

Protective eye wear will be provided and you will need to wear this at all times in the forging area.

Ear plugs will also be available.

Clothes:
