DIRECTIONS FROM THE EAST OR NORTH

From the M5 Junction 31 follow signs onto the A30 West, clearly signed to Okehampton/Bodmin. Continue along the dual carriageway to the exit sign-posted Okehampton (B3260), then exit the A30. At the end of the slip-road (with the BP garage on your left), turn right and drive down the hill into Okehampton. In the middle of the town you will come to traffic lights opposite the White Hart pub (on the far left). Go straight on at these lights and after one mile, at the top of the hill, turn right (sign-posted Northlew). Continue along this road for half a mile and take the right turn sign-posted Northlew. Continue on this road for 0.3 miles, then go straight on at the Hilltown Cross crossroads. The Grange EC is 1.5 miles further along this road, on the left.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE WEST OR SOUTH

Exit the A30 at Sourton Cross (A386 sign-posted Tavistock/Bideford) following signs to Bideford. Go past the Shell filling station and the Little Chef restaurant on your left and follow the road for 2.1 miles until you come to a mini-roundabout (Fowley Cross). Turn right, following signs to Bideford. After 0.4 miles turn left at the mini-roundabout (sign-posted to Northlew). After a further 0.2 miles take the second left, sign-posted to Northlew. The Grange EC is 1.5 miles along this road, on the left.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31st July to the 2ndAugust 2018

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to the 3rd place if the 1st & 2nd ponies are already qualified. NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring.

NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. Ponies must be plaited. Classes open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years & over.

Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31st July to the 2ndAugust 2018

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may go no lower than third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. Owner's membership cards must be shown in the ring.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships:

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS.

If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championship. **Membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive the Silver Medal and/or Silver Medal Qualification**.

- 1. The organizers and each of the show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving , or for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show.
- 2. This show is run under the showing and competition rules of the National Pony Society (NPS).
- 3. In all classes the judge's decision is final.
- 4. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 31st July - 2nd of August 2017
- 5. Any person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class and at the same time shall deposit a sum of ± 10 . If the investigation by the committee shows the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall forfeit to the funds of the show. The committee's decision will be final.
- 6. All Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered with their respective breed society and be shown in accordance with their individual society rules.
- 7. The organisers reserve the right to amend the judges' panel and order of classes if it should become necessary
- 8. The committee cannot be held responsible for the clashing of classes competitors should bear this in mind when making their entries. No entry fees will be refunded.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if deemed necessary.
- 10. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.
- 11. The committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
- 12. Stallions and colts. In hand classes: handlers must have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. - 17. Stallion Discs- All in Hand Stallions MUST display a bridle disc when showing in NPS classes. As with ridden stallions, for which it remains compulsory, these may be from any UK society as long as they are easily identified or an NPS Stallion Disc.
