GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The organisers and each of the show's officers, servants or agents shall not be in any way responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatsoever) to exhibitors or their servants or agents or other members of the public, to any animal or property, or to any vehicle brought onto the showground, or on premises used in conjunction with the show, or while entering or leaving, or for anything else in conjunction with, or arising out of, or attributable to the show.
- 2. This show is run under the showing and competition rules of the National Pony Society (NPS).
- 3. In all classes the judge's decision is final.
- 4. Any person wishing to lodge a protest having reference to any persons or exhibit, shall do so in writing within 30 minutes of the completion of the class and at the same time shall deposit a sum of £20. If the investigation by the committee shows the protest is not sustained, the deposit shall be forfeited to the funds of the show. The committee's decision will be final.
- 5. All Mountain and Moorland ponies must be registered with their respective breed society and be shown in accordance with their individual society rules.
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to amend the judges' panel and order of classes if it should become necessary.
- 7. The committee cannot be held responsible for the clashing of classes therefore competitors should bear this in mind when making their entries. No entry fees will be refunded.
- 8. The committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes if deemed necessary.
- 9. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.
- 10. The committee reserves the right to retain all or part of the entry fees in the event of the show being cancelled.
- 11. Rider's and handler's age, attire and equipment must comply with NPS showing and competition rules at the time of the show.
- 12. No pony under the age of 4 may compete in any ridden class.
- 13. Spurs are not allowed in any ridden class.
- 14. Anyone found mistreating a horse or pony may be asked to leave the showground and be reported to the appropriate body.
- 15. All dogs must be kept on a lead.

New Classes for 2018 – A new Championship will be held at the NPS Summer Championships for Part Bred Arab and Part Bred Native horses and ponies. Qualifying rounds may be held for both in hand and ridden animals, with no upper height limit. Classes may be split between horses/ponies with a minimum of 12.5% Arab blood and horses/ponies with a minimum of 12.5% M&M blood

Summer Championship Qualifiers

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: these classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **31 July – 2 August 2018.**

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated with an *. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. All qualifying ponies will receive a qualification card. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

To be run under NPS Rules 2018

Class 7 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms.

Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Ponies may be shown in any suitable bridle. Ponies not to have won a first prize in any first ridden class or qualified for the NPS showing classics M&M first ridden final before 1st January in the current year.

To be run under NPS Rules 2018

Class 8* Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A, Welsh B mares and geldings. Rider not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 9* Large Breeds (not exceeding 138 cms) Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh C mares and geldings. Rider not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 10* Large Breeds (exceeding 138 cms but not exceeding 148 cms) Fell, Highland New Forest, Connemara, Dales (may exceed 148 cms), Welsh D (may exceed 148 cms) mares and geldings. Rider not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 11* Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A & B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122 cm. Class 12* Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A & B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

There are no specific registration criteria for ponies. The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying member to enter the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show 31 July – 2 August 2018.

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an **NPS Qualifying or Life** member in the M&M Ridden section. Membership cards MUST be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

Summer championship qualifiers

NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds: these classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Books, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Books, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. Ponies must be plaited. Classes open to stallions, mares and geldings 4 years old and over.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from $31 \, July - 2 \, August \, 2018$.

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

All qualifying ponies will receive a qualification card. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS/EQUISSAGE PULSE Hack & Riding Horse In Hand Supreme Championship

Class 32 Hacks & Riding Horses four years old and over, stallions and mares

Class 33 Hacks & Riding Horses three years old and under, colts fillies and geldings

The owner does not have to be an NPS member to enter the competition, to qualify or to enter the Final. The first placed horse in each class will qualify for the final at NPS Summer Championship Show. Qualification may go no lower than third place. Foals are excluded from qualifying.

The NPS In Hand Part Bred National Championship

To be run under NPS Rules 2018 Horse or Pony of any Age.

Class 34 Part Bred Arab. Horse/pony to be registered in the part bred or Anglo Arab section of the Arab Horse Society with a minimum of 12.5% Arab blood.

Class 35 Part Bred M&M. Horse/pony to be registered in the part bred section of one of the M&M Stud books with a minimum of 12.5% of that breed blood.

NPS/AREA XI British Isles Area In-Hand Championship Qualifier

The winning pony from each of the in hand classes held at the show is eligible to go forward to this championship. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies.

The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying member to enter the final at the NPS Summer Championship 31 July – 2 August 2018.

NPS Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony First Ridden National Championship

To be run under NPS Rules 2018

Class 37* Open to registered mares and geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in any suitable snaffle bit.

Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony NOVICE Leading Rein No final at NPS Summer Championship.

To be run under NPS Rules 2018

Class 38 Open to registered mares and geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 8th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony never to have won a 1st prize of £5 or more in any SP/SHP leading rein class before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony NOVICE First Ridden No final at NPS Summer Championship.

To be run under NPS Rules 2018

Class 39 Open to registered mares and geldings 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cm. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 10th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Pony never to have won a 1st prize of £5 or more in any SP/SHP first ridden class before 1st January in the current year. Ponies must be shown in any suitable snaffle bit.

NPS/L P PALLET EQUESTRIAN SANDS, Show Pony/Show Hunter NOVICE Ridden Championship

To be run under NPS Rules 2018 May be amalgamated if insufficient entries.

Class 40 Novice Show Pony not exceeding 148cm.

Pony not to have been placed first in any Open Affiliated Ridden Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony class (excluding Leading Rein or First Ridden). Pony not to have qualified for RIHS or Horse of the Year Show

To be run under NPS Rules 2018. May be amalgamated if insufficient entries.

Riders to be of a suitable size for the pony. Riders must be 12 years old or over when riding stallions not exceeding 128 cm and 14 years old or over when riding stallions exceeding 128 cms.
