# Dairy Heifer Young Handler

Conditions:

- 1 Only Heifers under 30 months of age to be used in this class. Please note that the animal should match the size of the Handler.
- 2 In these classes it is the handler that is judged and not the animal. Normal showing attire must be worn during judging. No rosettes to be displayed in the ring.
- 3 Owners of the cattle must ensure that the young person is capable of controlling the animal being shown. Children must always be under the supervision of and accompanied by a competent adult.
- 5 The judge has the authority to ask any exhibitor not having sufficient control of his/her animal to leave the ring.
- 6 The age boundaries of the classes may be amended by the Stewards to suit the ages of entries forward on the day.
