91	Special Prize	For the Best Turnout owned and driven by a member of the Lincolnshire Agricultural Society, resident in Lincolnshire. (WHITE arm bands to be worn by eligible competitors) LAS TROPHY: PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP (132), presented by J E England & Sons Ltd.
93	Harness Horse and Pony of the Year Championship.	Horse of the Year Show Qualifier 2025 Champion: LAS Rosette and BDS Rosette Reserve: LAS Rosette and BDS Rosette
94	Concours d'Elegance	CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE REGULATIONS: This class is held under the rules of the British Driving Society and Exhibitors must be members of that Society. ALL turnouts which have been separately entered in the Private Driving Classes are eligible to compete. THE CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE is designed to establish the most elegant turnout. The essence of the competition is the word "elegance" and the winner will be the turnout which, in the opinion of the Judge, presents the most elegant effect. This will obviously include vehicle, horse, driver, passengers, etc., but above all, the general impression. Attention may well be paid to drivers' and passengers' personal costume, as it may contribute to the overall picture, but a fancy dress or period costume is definitely barred. The whole object of the class is to establish which turnout presents the most pleasing picture and normal judging criteria do not apply. It is judged from a distance and vehicles are NOT closely inspected as in ordinary show classes. To be driven at park pace.
S92	Special Rosette for the Best YOUNG WHIP.	Open to drivers between the ages of 10-21 years (not to be 21 before 1st of January 2025) This class is judged on the ability of the driver and not on the horse/turnout. (RED armbands to be worn by eligible competitors).
88	SINGLE HARNESS, PAIRS or TANDEM	Not exceeding 138cm (13.2hh) non-hackney type. All horses must be aged 4 years old or over. For the Best Entry in this Class: LAS TROPHY: PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP (128), presented by the Late Mrs B Elston.
89	SINGLE HARNESS, PAIRS or TANDEM	Over 138cm. (13.2h.h) non-hackney type. All horses must be aged 4 years old or over.
90	SINGLE HARNESS, PAIRS or TANDEM	Any height, hackney or hackney type. All horses must be aged 4 years old or over.
