An exhibit to be staged on tables covered in pale green fabric. Open to any competitor who has not won a 1st prize in floral art in a NAFAS or RHS competition. To be viewed and judged from the front.

Competition Rules

- 1. Staging may commence 10.00am on Tuesday 7 September 2021. All exhibits must be completed by 6.00am on Wednesday 8 September 2021. At this point all competitors must leave the marquee in preparation for judging.
- 2. Classes F2 F11 must be staged by only one competitor.
- 3. Competitors must not remove exhibits before the close of show on Thursday 9 September at 6.00pm.
- Classes F1 F11 will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual (2015 green book). It is strongly recommended that all competitors staging flower arrangements refer to this manual.
- 5. Pre-prepared work is allowed in all classes unless stated otherwise in the schedule.
- 6. Entry fees* include a vehicle pass and 1 exhibitor wristband. Class F1 entitles 4 exhibitor wristbands. Exhibitor passes are valid for both days of the County Show.
- 7. Exhibitors may apply for additional passes at the discounted rate of £12.00, subject to being purchased on or before the closing date for entries. Maximum 4 extra passes per exhibitor. All exhibitor passes are non-refundable and no refunds or replacements will be given in respect of any lost, forgotten or unused passes.
- 8. Entries can be made online (www.westmorlandshow.org.uk) or via the official entry form.
- 9. Prizes presented at 4.00pm on Thursday 9 September 2021.
