1	A Carrot Cake - set recipe	<p>Class 1 – Carrot Cake</p> <p>Cake Ingredients –</p> <p>225g self-raising flour</p> <p>1 level teaspoon baking powder</p> <p>1 teaspoon mixed spice</p> <p>150g light brown sugar</p> <p>50g chopped walnuts</p> <p>100g carrots (washed, trimmed, and coarsely grated)</p> <p>2 x large eggs</p> <p>150ml sunflower oil</p> <p>Topping Ingredients –</p> <p>50g softened butter</p> <p>50g full fat cream cheese</p> <p>150g icing sugar</p> <p>½ teaspoon vanilla extract</p> <p>Walnuts to decorate</p> <p>Line and grease a deep cake tin – approx. 20cm diam – with baking paper</p> <p>Preheat oven to 180C/Fan 160C/Gas Mark 4</p> <p>Method –</p> <p>In a large bowl sift together the flour and baking powder and mixed spice. Stir in the sugar. Add the chopped nuts and grated carrot and mix lightly.</p> <p>Make a well in the centre, add the eggs and oil and beat until it is thoroughly mixed.</p> <p>Pour the mixture into the cake tin and place in preheated oven for approx. 1 - 1 ¼ hours, (test with a skewer) or until golden brown and shrinking from the sides of the tin.</p> <p>Once baked, remove from tin, remove paper and leave to cool.</p> <p>Topping –</p> <p>Place all ingredients in a bowl and mix thoroughly. Spread evenly over the top of the cake. Decorate with walnuts. Leave to harden slightly in a cool place and display on a plate.</p>

9	4 Ginger Biscuits – set recipe – see details	<p>Class 9 – 4 Ginger Biscuits</p> <p>Ingredients – (makes approx. 20 biscuits)</p> <p>85g butter, 115g golden syrup, 225g self-raising flour, 115g caster sugar,</p> <p>2 tsp ground ginger</p> <p>Heat oven to 180C/160C Fan/Gas 4</p> <p>Line a baking tray with baking parchment</p> <p>Method –</p>

		<p>Sift flour and ginger into a bowl and mix in sugar.</p> <p>Melt butter and syrup in a pan (or in the microwave) and stir.</p> <p>Add to dry ingredients and mix until well combined.</p> <p>Leave the mixture to cool slightly before rolling the dough into balls – about 1 tsp of dough/walnut size ball.</p> <p>Place onto baking tray, leaving space, as biscuits will spread whilst cooking.</p> <p>Bake for 10-15 mins or until golden brown. Leave to cool for approx. 5 mins before removing from tray and transferring to a wire rack to cool completely.</p> <p>Select your best four!</p>
