Every animal must be entered, accepted for entry, or eligible for entry in the Davy's Devon Herd Book, its polled register or one of its supplementary registers AND be at least 87.5% pure Devon bred by any route or an officially approved Devon herd book of an EU Member State.

The Devon Cattle Breeders' Society will award the Holwell Manor (West) Cup (won outright by R T and M P Wilson and represented as the Bartridge Decanter) to the member gaining the most points from the following Shows: Camelford, Holsworthy & Stratton, Launceston, North Devon, Okehampton and Woolsery. Points awarded as follows: (1 point per entry forward - cow and calf = 1 point). First prize = 5 points, Second Prize = 4 points, Third Prize = 3 points.
